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18	WHEREAS Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is a corporation continued and
19	existing under the <i>Hydro Corporation Act</i> , is a public utility within the meaning of the <i>Act</i> , and
20	is also subject to the provisions of the <i>EPCA</i> ; and
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22	WHEREAS section 90 of the Act gives the Board the authority and discretion to award costs in
23	a proceeding before the Board; and
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25	WHEREAS in Order No. P.U. 17(2016) the Board found that the Industrial Customer Group
26	(Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited, NARL Refining Limited Partnership and Teck
27	Resources Limited) was entitled to an award of costs; and
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29	WHEREAS the Industrial Customer Group filed a cost submission with the Board for approval
30	of costs in the amount of \$5,665.94 (exclusive of HST); and

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1. The costs of the Industrial Customer Group are fixed at \$5,665.94, exclusive of HST.

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2. Hydro shall, within thirty days, pay costs to the Industrial Customer Group in the amount of \$5,665.94.
