22	WHEREAS Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is a corporation continued and
23.	existing under the <i>Hydro Corporation Act</i> , is a public utility within the meaning of the <i>Act</i> , and

26	WHEREAS section 90 of the Act gives the Board the authority and discretion to award costs in

WHEREAS the Industrial Customer Group states that an assessment of Hydro's interim rate proposals required their full intervention and participation, as well as review and analysis by their consultants, and that an award of costs to the Industrial Customer Group is reasonable; and

WHEREAS in response to the Board's request for comments on the bill of costs, Hydro requested that the Board exercise its discretion in determining the amount of costs to be awarded to the Industrial Customer Group; and

WHEREAS the Board finds that the participation of the Industrial Customer Group was helpful to the Board in its consideration of the matter and contributed to the Board's understanding of the issues; and

WHEREAS the Board has reviewed the bill of costs submitted by the Industrial Customer Group and is satisfied that its costs should be fixed in the amount of \$6,827.75 (exclusive of HST).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The costs of the Industrial Customer Group are fixed at \$6,827.75, exclusive of HST.

2. Hydro shall, within thirty days, pay costs to the Industrial Customer Group in the amount of \$6,827.75.
