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28	WHEREAS Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is a corporation continued and
29	existing under the <i>Hydro Corporation Act</i> , 2007, is a public utility within the meaning of the <i>Act</i> ,
30	and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and
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32	WHEREAS Hydro filed its 2018 Capital Budget Application with the Board of Commissioners
33	of Public Utilities (the "Board") on July 27, 2017; and

35	WHEREAS on December 22, 2017 the Board issued Order No. P.U. 43(2017) approving Hydro's
36	2018 Capital Budget in the amount of \$170,868,300 and deferring consideration of two projects
37	on the basis that further information was required (the Hydraulic Generation Refurbishment and

1 Modernization project, and the Muskrat Falls to Happy Valley – Goose Bay Interconnection project); and

**WHEREAS** on January 29, 2018 pursuant to Order No. P.U. 43(2017) Hydro submitted revised documentation relating to the two deferred projects; and

 WHEREAS on February 12, 2018 the Board advised the Consumer Advocate, Dennis Browne, Q.C.; Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power"); and Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited, NARL Refining LP, and Vale Newfoundland and Labrador Limited ("Industrial Customer Group") that further submissions may be filed regarding the revised documentation filed by Hydro; and

**WHEREAS** on February 16, 2018 Newfoundland Power filed its submission stating that it was satisfied that the additional information submitted in support of the *Hydraulic Generation Refurbishment and Modernization* project is sufficient to enable the Board to approve the project; and

**WHEREAS** on February 16, 2018 the Industrial Customer Group advised that the group had no comments on the revised information filed pursuant to Board Order No. P.U. 43(2017); and

**WHEREAS** on February 16, 2018 the Labrador Interconnected Group (Labrador City, Wabush, Happy Valley-Goose Bay and Sheshatshiu Innu First Nation) and the Iron Ore Company of Canada ("IOC") filed requests for intervenor status and submissions relating to the *Muskrat Falls to Happy Valley – Goose Bay Interconnection* project; and

**WHEREAS** on February 22, 2018 Hydro filed further submissions which stated that the *Hydraulic Generation Refurbishment and Modernization* project should be approved as filed given that Newfoundland Power was of the opinion that this project should be approved and that IOC and the Labrador Interconnected Group did not comment on this project; and

**WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the *Hydraulic Generation Refurbishment and Modernization* project should be addressed at this time and the *Muskrat Falls to Happy Valley – Goose Bay Interconnection* project should be addressed in a subsequent Order of the Board; and

**WHEREAS** the Board has reviewed the additional information filed by Hydro in relation to the *Hydraulic Generation Refurbishment and Modernization* project and is satisfied that the revised format of the information facilitates a better understanding of the twelve individual projects and meets the requirements of the legislation and the Capital Budget Guidelines and that the information filed adequately details the proposed expenditures, the individual justifications, and potential alternatives; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed capital expenditures in relation to the Hydraulic Generation Refurbishment and Modernization project are reasonable and necessary to ensure the continued provision of a safe and reliable electricity supply to Hydro's customers.

## **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

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1. Hydro's proposed capital expenditures for *Hydraulic Generation Refurbishment and Modernization* in the amount of \$10,325,400 in 2018 and \$4,283,100 in 2019 are approved.

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2. Hydro's multi-year construction and purchase of improvements or additions to its property in excess of \$50,000 to begin in 2018 approved in Order No. P.U. 43(2017) are amended, as set out in Schedule A to this Order.

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Hydro's 2018 Capital Budget for improvements or additions to its property approved in Order
No. P.U. 43(2017) is amended, as set out in Schedule B to this Order.

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4. Hydro shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this application.
