AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1
3 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL
4 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as amended,
5 and regulations thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
8 Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of
9 a Contribution in Aid of Construction for
10 a single-phase extension to Skibbereen Road,
11 pursuant to section 41 of the *Act*.

14 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly organized
15 and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public utility
16 within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and

18 **WHEREAS** on June 13, 2019 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a
19 Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) for a single-phase extension of approximately 2,130
20 metres (the “Extension”) to serve eight (8) Domestic customers located in a residential planning
21 area known as Skibbereen Road, located in the Town of Holyrood; and

23 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution
24 Line Extensions to Domestic Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27(2005) (the “Policy”) is
25 eight thousand eight hundred fifteen dollars and twenty five cents (\$8,815.25), excluding HST;

28 **WHEREAS** the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) and the Basic Investment
29 calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$99,762.00; and
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
31 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(i) of the Policy states that approval of the Board is required where the sum
32 of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) or 6(a) and the Basic Investment calculated
33 pursuant to Clauses 3 and 4 are estimated to be greater than \$50,000; and

35 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power’s investment in
36 the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment
37 of its other customers.

1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of eight thousand eight hundred fifteen
4 dollars and twenty five cents (\$8,815.25), excluding HST, to apply to Domestic customers
5 located in the Skibbereen Road Residential Development located in the Town of Holyrood,
6 is approved.

8 2. Newfoundland Power Inc. shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
