8	Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of a
9	contribution towards the cost of relocating
10	portions of its transmission lines for Newfoundland
11	and Labrador Hydro, pursuant to section 41(5) of
12	the Act .

15	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly organized
16	and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public utility
17	within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and
18	
19	WHEREAS section 41(5) of the Act states a public utility that intends to demand from its
20	customers a contribution towards the cost of improvements or additions to its property shall not
21	demand the contribution without the prior approval of the Board; and
22	
23	WHEREAS Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") has requested that Newfoundland
24	Power relocate portions of transmission lines 38L and 39L to accommodate the approved early
25	execution capital work required for the proposed construction of the Avalon Combustion
26	Turbine; and
27	
28	WHEREAS the construction cost of the proposed line relocation less any betterment, based on a
29	detailed engineering estimate, is \$1,012,231, excluding HST; and
30	
31	WHEREAS on October 3, 2025 Newfoundland Power filed an application with the Board
32	requesting approval of a contribution from Hydro in the amount is \$1,012,231, excluding HST
33	(the "Application"); and

WHEREAS Newfoundland Power stated that if the actual construction costs differ from the estimate, Hydro will be charged or refunded the difference; and

WHEREAS the proposed contribution by Hydro is necessary to ensure that the costs associated with the relocation of portions of transmission lines 38L and 39L are borne by the customer requesting the relocation.
