RE: Approval of Construction of the Muskrat Falls to Happy Valley Interconnection

Please note the Town of Happy Valley-Goose Bay's support for the application by NL Hydro to construct the Muskrat Falls to Happy Valley Interconnection (MFHVI). The Town feels that the existing direct connection to the Town from Churchill Falls has outlived its useful life and needs replacement. This interconnection with Muskrat Falls will provide the Upper Lake Melville area with a considerably enhanced reliable source of power with increased capacity as compared to the marginal capacity presently available with the possibility of frequent and extended power outages. The Town would expect that a suitable Network Expansion Policy will be put in place by NL Hydro to protect all existing Labrador Interconnected rate payers.
