Transmission component of Labrador Industrial Customer rates, effective January 1, 2015**


This is further to the Board's correspondence to Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (Hydro) dated December 4, 2014. In that letter the Board requested that Hydro advise immediately as to all customers and known potential customers that may be affected by this rate, indicating whether these customers have been provided notice of the application and whether they have consented to the proposed rate.

Hydro can advise that it has discussed the matter of the proposed rates for 2015 with the Labrador Industrial Customers, however, Hydro has not provided formal notice to these customers as to the proposed transmission rates in Hydro's amended general rate application. Hydro is in the process of preparing formal notice to provide to Labrador Industrial Customers and will provide a copy to the Board upon provision to the Labrador Industrial Customers.
