Q. Following the March 4, 2015 outage event Hydro implemented practices which impacted the utilization of standby generation. Please provide details of any changes made to operating requirements and/or maintenance strategy for the Holyrood CT following the implementation of these practices.

A. Following the March 4, 2015 outage event, which primarily impacted the Avalon Peninsula, Hydro reviewed its transmission reliability criteria and commenced the practice of operating standby generating units that support the Avalon in advance of Avalon transmission system contingencies, rather than starting its standby generating units after the event has occurred. To provide for this enhanced customer reliability, the starting and operating requirements for the Avalon standby generation, including the Holyrood CT has increased. This change in starting and operating requirements does not change the manufacturer's recommended maintenance strategy for the Holyrood CT. Rather, the timing of the maintenance

interventions within this strategy was impacted as a result of increased utilization.
