1 Q. Please provide Holyrood's Unit Availability Statistics for 2012 to 2015.

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4 A. The statistics which provide an overview of Holyrood's availability are:

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Derated Adjusted Forced Outage Rate (DAFOR) - measures the percentage of time
that a unit or group of units is unable to generate at its Maximum Continuous
Rating (MCR) due to forced outages. The plant rate is weighted to reflect
differences in generating unit sizes.

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Capability Factor (CF) – measures the percentage of time that a unit or a group of units is available to supply power at maximum continuous generating capacity. The plant factor is weighted to reflect the difference in generating unit sizes, meaning larger units have a greater impact on this measure.
