Was the TL needed in 2008 as stated in the 2008 Hatch 8 9 report? 10 11 12 Α. No, the transmission line was not required in 2008. Please note the Hatch report 13 did not state the TL was needed in 2008, but rather discussed future upgrades that 14 would be required under various conditions. 15 16 The statement in the 2008 Hatch report is consistent with the explanation in Nalcor's response to PUB-Nalcor-153. The line would be required in the Isolated 17 18 Island alternative in order to integrate generation sources west of the Avalon 19 Peninsula.
