

1 Q. **Re: B-7, Upgrade Marine Terminal – Holyrood \$5,859,600 in 2012**

2 At page B14 of the Hatch report it is stated that: *“Currently, vessels of less than*
3 *55,000DWT and shorter than 656 ft long are able to dock at the jetty, as docking is*
4 *being performed in a controlled manner with a very low impact velocity.”* Provide
5 an explanation as to how many years these vessels have been delivering to the
6 Marine Terminal and any incidents that have occurred.

9 A. For the past three years, vessels less than 55,000 DWT and less than 200 m have
10 been delivering fuel. Vessels berthing at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station
11 Marine Terminal have been assisted by tugs since early 2010. There have been no
12 incidents within the past three years related to berthing.
