Q. Re: B-68, Condition Assessment & Life Extension Phase 2 - \$1,215,700 in 2012 1 2 In Volume II, Tab 25, page 13, Hydro states that as a part of the AMEC Study in 2010 3 a Level 2 condition assessment was carried out on the Marine Terminal. This 4 assessment was to be completed in September 2011. How does this assessment 5 relate to the capital budget for the Marine Terminal submitted in Hydro's 2012 6 Capital Budget Application? 7 8 9 A. This question can be addressed by providing clarification to Section 4.3 on page 13 10 of the report. The Level 2 condition assessment carried out on the Marine Terminal 11 was not carried out by AMEC. It was completed in 2010 by a different engineering 12 firm, Hatch, and was a more detailed piece of work than a Level 1 assessment. 13 Hatch had previous experience with the Marine Terminal and Hydro believed that 14 their previous experience with this structure would be beneficial in completing the 15 Level 2 assessment. The Hatch report was filed with the Board as Appendix B of the 16 proposal titled "Refurbishment of Marine Terminal at the Holyrood Thermal 17 Generating Station" submitted as part of the 2012 Application. 18 19 The study referred to in Volume II, Tab 25, page 13, to be completed in September 20 2011, is for a Level 2 condition assessment of the gas turbine plant at Holyrood. This 21 study is presently being completed by AMEC. The more detailed Level 2 assessment 22 was completed because the gas turbine plant is in poor condition and has 23 developed serious operational problems. The final report for the Level 2 24 assessment will be submitted as a supporting document in a future proposal to the 25 Board requesting budget approval to either refurbish or replace the gas turbine 26 plant.
