8		iii)	In relation to Hydro's plan to request proposals in each and every year of
9			this project, as set out at page 16, is it practical for a firm other than AMEC
10			to do any aspect of Phase 2 not having completed Phase 1?

13	A.	i)	Hydro only sought approval of expenditures in 2012 because the actual cost
14			of the work to be competed in 2012 will provide the best information in
15			preparing the most accurate cost estimates for future years.
16			
17		ii)	Yes, a report will be prepared at the conclusion of the 2012 work so that the
18			recommendations can be considered.
19			
20		ii)	Yes, it is practical for a firm other than AMEC to do some aspects of Phase 2
21			not having completed Phase 1. For example, it is anticipated that the work
22			associated with boiler inspection and testing will be performed by Hydro's
23			service contractor for the boilers who have professional engineers on staff
24			and are normally most knowledgeable on the internals of the boilers and
25			their original design details.
