Q. Please explain why there was a \$8 million allowance for the construction of the
building rather than going to public tender in this province.

A. There was an \$8 million allowance for the construction of the building rather than going to public tender in this province because the building had to be a customized design that would suit the plant configuration being offered by the successful tenderer. The design requirements and criteria for the building depend on the related design requirements for the combustion turbine and balance of plant equipment, and is therefore an integral part of the design being executed as part of the EPC contractor. The amount to be paid will be the actual construction cost of the new building. The actual construction cost may differ from the \$8 million allowance.
