1	Q.	On page 9 of the Supply and Install 100 MW (Nominal) of Combustion Turbine
2		Generation report, Hydro states:
3		"As well, for added security in the event of higher demands, decreased reliability
4		or for schedule slippage of the proposed combustion turbine proposed in service
5		date, Hydro is proposing to negotiate interruptible contracts with major industrial
6		customers at least for 2014-2015."
7		Is Hydro seeking approval from the Board to begin negotiations as a part of this
8		Application?
9		
10		
11	A.	Hydro has already begun negotiations with major Industrial Customers regarding
12		interruptible contracts. The details around scope and cost of any such
13		arrangements will be provided in a future application to the Board, as required.
