New Transmission Line Bay d'Espoir to Western Avalon

THE APPLICATION

On April 30, 2014 the Board received an application from Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro requesting an Order for approval of a capital expenditure in the amount of \$291,700,000 for the construction of a new 230 kV transmission line between the Bay d'Espoir and Western Avalon Terminal Stations.

Customers of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro and Newfoundland Power Inc. may be affected by the outcome of this application. The costs of this project, if approved by the Board, will be recovered in customers' rates. Hydro estimates that the project will result in an approximate rate increase of 3 per cent at a wholesale level and 2 to 2.5 per cent at a retail level, based on an estimate of forecast system costs at the planned time of commissioning in 2018.
