Dear Mr. Young:

Re: Island Interconnected System - Recent Supply Issues and Power Outages – Status Reports

Commencing Monday, January 10, 2014 and continuing until advised otherwise, the Board requests that Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) file, by 9:00 am each morning, a report on the status of the Island Interconnected system providing at a minimum the following information:

1. The previous day's peak demand;
2. The previous day's total available generation from Hydro sources only;
3. The previous day's total available generation from all sources; and
4. The forecast peak for the current day.

Reports for Friday, Saturday and Sunday are to be filed on Monday mornings.

In addition, Hydro is to report immediately to the Board of any change in the status of generation capacity serving the Island Interconnected system, including the return to service or increase in rating of any generating unit, the loss of any generating unit from any source for any reason, and any reduction in generation capacity of any unit equivalent to 25% or greater of the unit's capacity.
