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Q: At page ES-2 of the report Liberty notes that full in-service of Muskrat Falls has been delayed until the winter of 2020-21 versus the originally planned winter of 2017-18. Please comment on whether the risk of inadequate supply on the IIS pre-Muskrat Falls will be adequately addressed when first power is provided by Muskrat Falls as planned now in winter of 2019-20, or will this risk only be adequately addressed when full in-service of Muskrat Falls occurs?

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A. Successful and reliable operation of the Labrador Island Link, if that is indeed
achieved in 2019-20, even with only partial capacity available from Muskrat Falls,
will mitigate the risk of inadequate supply. The degree of such mitigation, up to and
including the potential to consider the risk as adequately addressed, will depend on
the amount of capacity available and the reliability of delivery in 2019-20.
