1 Q. At page i, lines 22-24, Hydro states that:

2 Should aspects of the supplemental projects not be completed within this time frame [prior to 3 the 2020-2021 winter season] Hydro will inform the Board...and provide mitigation plans.

Has Hydro already developed any mitigation plans for this contingency?

A. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") closely monitors its supply-related assets to ensure its ability to provide reliable service to customers. The availability of power from the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station ("Holyrood TGS") remains a critical component of Hydro's supply resources in advance of reliable service from the Muskrat Falls Project assets.

With respect to system risk, in 2018, Hydro implemented a contingency plan for incremental internal and external system support for future winter seasons should the Labrador-Island Link ("LIL") be unavailable. The implementation of this plan has resulted in increased system reliability that would also be of benefit in the event of increased unavailability of the Holyrood TGS. In addition, Hydro will work with Nalcor Energy Marketing to secure incremental supply from the market, should it be required. Please refer Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-001 for further detail.

With respect to project execution, mitigation efforts for the four projects are focused on avoiding execution delays and scheduling of human resources and outages. Hydro is working on the procurement of long lead parts, completing advanced coordination and planning with contractors, advancing project planning and scheduling, and prioritizing critical work. In addition, Hydro has adjusted its work plans to reduce the risk of COVID-19 impacts (e.g., daily screening, crew separation, Personal Protective Equipment protocols and longer shifts, where necessary). Options for additional unit outages and/or extensions within the maintenance season are also being contemplated to accommodate the necessary work.
