Q.	Figure 2 on Page 2 of the Engineering Report indicates that chargers will not be built on the
	Northern Peninsula. Please provide an explanation for the network not extending to the
	Northern Peninsula at this time, and advise of any future plans to install chargers at other
	locations.
Α.	Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") determined its locations for the proposed Level 3
	Direct Current Fast Chargers ("DCFC") and Level 2 Chargers based on the route of the Trans
	Canada Highway and the year-round connection of the island to mainland Canada at the Port
	Aux Basques ferry terminal. This scope exhausted the funds currently available to Hydro for the
	project and, therefore, Hydro is not proposing any chargers for the Northern Peninsula at this
	time. Hydro has preliminary plans for additional Level 3 DCFC locations across the province,
	including the Northern Peninsula and Labrador; however, these plans require additional funding
	which Hydro has not secured at this time.
