2 There are no purchase meters and metering equipment costs for 2021 or 2022. How does Hydro
3 intend to install meters required for GRO's, stopped meters, and new services? Are these items
4 accounted for in the \$100,000 amount for purchase meters and metering equipment from 2023
5 to 2026?

8 A. For 2021, Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") has already purchased meters to deal
9 with Government Retest Orders ("GRO"), stopped meters, and new services. For 2022,
10 Measurement Canada has indicated Hydro does not need to complete GROs for meters planned
11 to be replaced as part of the proposed meter replacement project. Hydro plans to use its
12 existing inventory for stopped meters and new services.
