NOTICE OF APPLICATION

NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO APPLICATION FOR NON-FIRM RATES

THE APPLICATION

On September 15, 2022 the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities received an application from Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro requesting an Order approving:

- i) the discontinuance of Rate No. 5.1L, Secondary Energy, which was available for customers on the Labrador Interconnected system;
- ii) Rate No. 5.1L, Non-Firm Energy, to be available for customers on the Labrador Interconnected system; and
- iii) modification of the non-firm component of the Island Industrial Customer Rate Sheet.

The application states that Hydro has determined that there is available non-firm transmission capacity in Labrador that could be utilized to provide non-firm service to a limited number of customers and that amendments to the non-firm component of the Island Industrial Customer Rate Sheet are required to reflect the change in the incremental cost of supplying non-firm energy to the Island Interconnected System.
