Re: Newfoundland Power Inc. – Application for Approval of October 1, 2019 Customer Rates

On September 13, 2019, Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") filed an application for approval of a revised schedule of rates, tolls and charges to be effective October 1, 2019.

On September 19, 2019, Grant Thornton's Financial Consultants Report in relation to Newfoundland Power's Proposed Changes to Customer Rates ("Grant Thornton Report") was distributed to Newfoundland Power, Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") and the Consumer Advocate. By correspondence also dated September 19, 2019, the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities ("Board") set Monday, September 23, 2019 as the deadline for comments from the parties.

Hydro notes that the Grant Thornton Report did not identify any discrepancies and found that the calculations and proposed revisions were appropriately prepared. Hydro submits that the Board should approve Newfoundland Power's application for approval of a revised schedule of rates, tolls and charges to be effective October 1, 2019.
