- Q. (Reference Application Schedule B, Personal Computer Infrastructure, page
 155) What is the average cost per computer replaced? Do personal computers
 typically have longer lives now than in the past?
- A. The average cost of a personal computer with warranty, display and dock is approximately \$2,600.¹

Newfoundland Power notes that the average life of mobile computing equipment as
 published by Gartner Inc., a leading advisor in global information technologies, is three
 years.² With the use of more mobile computing equipment to meet operational
 requirements, such as the use of notebooks and tablets, the Company's historical
 experience of an average five-year lifecycle for personal computers is expected to
 decrease, resulting in more frequent personal computer infrastructure replacements.³

⁸ The average life for computing equipment is currently five years, which is consistent 9 with historical estimates. This estimate was last reviewed as part of the Company's 10 *2019 Depreciation Study* completed by Gannett Fleming which was filed as part of 11 Newfoundland Power's *2022/2023 General Rate Application*. 12
