¹ Order P.U. 26(2021), p. 1: On July 7, 2021 the Board advised the parties that one of the projects included in the proposed Distribution expenditures, the Electric Vehicle Charging Network project, would be considered separately from the rest of the Application and that a process for consideration of this project would be scheduled at a later date upon the conclusion of the electrification application filed by Newfoundland Power. The removal of this project reduced the proposed expenditures by \$1,530,000, resulting in a proposed 2022 Capital Budget of \$108,121,000.
