

- 1 **Q. (Reference Application) Please provide a discussion of the consideration**  
2 **being given to non-wires alternatives (NWAs) in each Canadian jurisdiction**  
3 **addressing the current practices of Canadian integrated utilities, transmission**  
4 **companies and major distributors. Further, please provide a discussion of the**  
5 **consideration being given to NWAs in each Canadian jurisdiction addressing**  
6 **the current practices of Canadian regulators.**

- 8 A. *The Canadian Energy Efficiency Scorecard* (“Scorecard”) from Efficiency Canada provides  
9 a national perspective on non-wires alternatives (“NWAs”). The Scorecard summarizes  
10 NWAs activity in each province and territory. Results from the 2022 Scorecard were  
11 included in the response to request for information CA-NP-071 filed as part of  
12 Newfoundland Power’s *2024 Capital Budget Application*. The Scorecard is published  
13 every two years. The 2024 Scorecard will be available in November of 2024.<sup>1</sup>

- 15 Newfoundland Power has not completed a jurisdictional scan to identify utility or  
16 regulatory practices regarding NWAs in the interim. See the response to Request for  
17 Information CA-NP-186 for an update on NWAs in provinces and territories identified in  
18 the 2022 Scorecard, as well as Newfoundland Power’s approach to NWAs.
