Re: Newfoundland Power's 2025/2026 General Rate Application – Enclosing Moody's Credit Rating Report, Exhibit 4 (1st Revision) and PUB-NP-063 (1st Revision)

On April 30, 2024, Moody's Investors Service ("Moody's") issued a Credit Opinion on Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power" or the "Company") (the "2024 Moody's Report"). This report is an update to the Credit Opinion dated March 31, 2023, which was filed as part of the Company's 2025/2026 General Rate Application. The Company requests that the Board enter the 2024 Moody's Report as part of the hearing record.

Additionally, it has come to the Company's attention that the DBRS Morningstar ("DBRS") Rating Report for Newfoundland Power dated October 28, 2022, filed as part of the Company's 2025/2026 General Rate Application, was not the most recent DBRS report available at the time of filing.² DBRS issued a Rating Report for Newfoundland Power on October 13, 2023 (the "2023 DBRS Report"). As such, the Company has revised Exhibit 4 to include the 2023 DBRS Report. The Company has also revised the response to Request for Information PUB-NP-063 to correct the reference to the 2023 DBRS Report (see footnote 5 of that response).

The Company is enclosing ten copies of each of:

- (i) the 2024 Moody's Report;
- (ii) Exhibit 4 (1st Revision); and
- (iii) Response to Request for Information PUB-NP-063 (1st Revision).

We trust the foregoing and enclosed are found to be in order.
