**IN THE MATTER OF THE MOTOR CARRIER ACT,

**IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF  
The Town of Winterton  
FOR THE APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT OF A  
MOTOR CARRIER CERTIFICATE.**

**WHEREAS** by application dated March 24, 2003 and received by the Board on April 5, 2003, completed in accordance with the said Act and Regulations, The Town of Winterton applied to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities for approval of an amendment to Motor Carrier Certificate No. 4008 to delete the following service:

IRREGULAR ROUTE SPECIALTY AMBULANCE SERVICE for the transportation of persons requiring medical attention or under medical care upon the request of a medical doctor or registered nurse from Brownsdale, Sibley's Cove and Lead Cove to any hospital, nursing home, first aid station or home for senior citizens and upon the specific request of a medical doctor, registered nurse or a police officer between any two points within the province of Newfoundland and Labrador.

**WHEREAS** a notice of the application was not required to be published by the applicant in The Newfoundland Gazette, and

**WHEREAS** on April 23, 2003, the Town of Old Perlican applied to the Board to amend its Motor Carrier Certificate to include these communities, and

**WHEREAS** on June 2, 2003, the Department of Health and Community Services advised that it had agreed to the changes of both Motor Carrier Certificates, and

**WHEREAS** the Board is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, and that the applicant has met the requirements of the Motor Carrier Act and Regulations.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

The application of the Town of Winterton for an amendment to its Motor Carrier Certificate to delete the following service:

IRREGULAR ROUTE SPECIALTY AMBULANCE SERVICE for the transportation of persons requiring medical attention or under medical care upon the request of a medical doctor or registered nurse from Brownsdale, Sibley's Cove and Lead Cove to any hospital, nursing home, first aid station or home for senior citizens and upon the specific request of a medical doctor, registered nurse or a police officer between any two points within the province of Newfoundland and Labrador.
