13	WHEREAS on June 19, 2019 Co-operators General Insurance Company ("Co-operators")
14	applied to the Board for approval of a revised rating program for its Private Passenger
15	Automobiles class of business; and
16	
17	WHEREAS the revised rating program proposes rates that are higher than those currently
18	approved by the Board for certain coverages; and
19	
20	WHEREAS on July 23, 2019 the Board's actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman Limited ("Oliver
21	Wyman"), filed a report ("Oliver Wyman Report") of findings with the Board which identified
22	key areas of the filing for the Board's consideration; and

24	WHEREAS on July 25, 2019 the Oliver Wyman Report was forwarded to Co-operators for
25	comment; and

27	WHEREAS on July 31, 2019 Co-operators filed commentary in relation to the Oliver Wyman
28	Report; and
29	
30	WHEREAS the Board finds that Co-operators failed to justify its proposals related to the
31	expense provision; and
32	
33	WHEREAS Co-operators may file a revised rate proposal for its Private Passenger Automobiles
34	class of business reflecting the findings of the Board as set out in the Reasons for Decision to be
35	issued separately.
