19	for Motorcycles; and

21	WHEREAS Security National conducted an internal analysis and determined that a rate change
22	was not warranted; and

24	WHEREAS Security National proposed no additional rating program changes; and

26	WHEREAS the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board's Mandatory
27	Simplified Filing Guidelines and is supported; and

30	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
31	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the <i>Automobile Insurance Act</i> or the
32	Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
