13	WHEREAS on October 13, 2020 Aviva General Insurance Company ("Aviva Genco") applied to
14	the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory Simplified filing option
15	for its Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile insurance, effective February 1, 2021 for
16	new business and renewals; and
17	
18	WHEREAS the proposal includes the following types of Miscellaneous Vehicles: (i) All-Terrain
19	Vehicles, (ii) Motorcycles, (iii) Motorhomes, (iv) Snowmobiles and (v) Trailers and Camper Units;
20	and
21	
22	WHEREAS Aviva Genco does not have sufficient volume to perform any actuarial analysis for
23	Miscellaneous Vehicles; and
24	
25	WHEREAS Aviva Genco compared its average written premium against the industry average
26	written premium and determined that a rate change was not warranted; and
27	
28	WHEREAS Aviva Genco proposed no rating program changes; and
29	
30	WHEREAS the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board's Mandatory
31	Simplified Filing Guidelines and is supported; and
32	
33	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
34	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
35	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the

*Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.
