21	WHEREAS Traders compared its average written premium against the industry average written
22	premium and determined that a rate change was not warranted; and
23	WHERE AC Traders represed various rating resource shortes which results in an everall rate
24	WHEREAS Traders proposed various rating program changes which results in an overall rate
25 26	level impact of 0.02%; and
26 27	WHEREAS the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board's Mandatory
27 28	Simplified Filing Guidelines and is supported; and

31	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
