13 **WHEREAS** on March 5, 2021 the General Insurance Statistical Agency (“GISA”) issued Bulletin
14 No. GISA 2021-03 announcing changes to the Automobile Statistical Plan; and

16 **WHEREAS** on July 26, 2021 Facility Association submitted an application to implement the
17 required changes to align with GISA Bulletin No. GISA 2021-03; and

19 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposal is just and reasonable in the circumstances
20 and does not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the *Insurance Companies Act* or the
21 respective regulations thereunder.


24 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
