1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*  
2 *Insurance Act*, RSNL 1990, c. A-22,  
3 as amended, and regulations  
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application  
7 by Aviva Insurance Company of Canada  
8 for approval to update vehicle rate group  
9 tables for its Commercial Vehicles  
10 category of automobile insurance.

13 **WHEREAS** on February 22, 2021 Aviva Insurance Company of Canada applied to the Board for  
14 approval to adopt the 2021 MSRP and Listed Price New tables for its Commercial Vehicles  
15 category of automobile insurance; and  
16

17 **WHEREAS** the proposed changes are applicable to both Commercial Vehicles and Interurban  
18 Vehicles; and  
19

20 **WHEREAS** the overall impact of the rate group table update is -0.2% for Commercial Vehicles  
21 and -0.8% for Interurban Vehicles; and

23 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the  
24 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the  
25 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the  
26 *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.


- 31 1. The proposal received on February 22, 2021 from Aviva Insurance Company of Canada for its
