13	WHEREAS on March 11, 2022 Liberty Mutual Insurance Company ("Liberty") applied to the
14	Board for approval of a revised rating program under the IAO filing option for its Commercia
15	Vehicles category of automobile insurance; and

17	WHEREAS the IAO filing option may be used by insurers to adopt the most recent IAO rating
18	program accepted for use by the Board; and
19	
20	WHEREAS Liberty proposed to adopt the IAO rating program for Commercial Vehicles accepted
21	for use by the Board in Information Bulletin A.I. 2021-04 issued on June 8, 2021; and
22	
23	WHEREAS Liberty reported that it has zero exposures and thus does not have sufficient volume
24	to justify a rating program based on company specific data; and

26	WHEREAS the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the IAO Filing Guidelines and
27	is supported; and

29	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
30	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
31	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the
32	Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
